



## Providence Academy Health Office • Middle/Upper School Over-the-Counter Medication Authorization Form

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Minnesota state law (statute 121A.222) allows a secondary student to use nonprescription pain relief in the school setting without a written physicians order provided the medication is taken in a manner **consistent with the labeling of the medication**. Providence Academy must have received a written authorization from the parent or guardian and this authorization must be submitted each year. Providence Academy will require the medication be stored in the original container in the Health Office for Middle School students and administered by the School Nurse. Non-prescription medications **include only ibuprofen (Advil, Motrin) and acetaminophen (Tylenol)**.
