## School Supplies

### 2015-2016

The following items will provide students with the opportunity to begin the year in an organized manner. Some teachers may ask students to bring additional supplies in the first week of school. Many items may need to be replenished as needed throughout the year. Most supplies are needed for all classes—deviations from general supplies for specific classes are noted.

Remember, all supplies should be neutral—no “pop culture”.

#### **General Supplies for All Classes**

- Memory Stick minimum of 256MB to use in all classes

- 2-3 reams of loose leaf paper to be distributed among 3-ring binders

- 200 3x5” index cards for making flash cards
- Erasers
- Highlighter
- Backpack
