The need for host families exists because NET team members spend a year away from their own families to share their faith with PA students. Hosting obligations are generally for two weeks and are scheduled in advance to host two to four netters. General hosting responsibilities include:

*Breakfast:* At your house (which can be as simple as providing cereal and milk)

*Lunch:* Do not need to provide as they will eat school lunch

*Dinner:* Pack a bag for them to eat during evening school activities and make dinner 2-3 nights a week

Every team member has their own sleeping bag and pillow, so floors, couches, or air mattresses work just fine; beds are not necessary. The team provides their own transportation and do not rely on hosts for taking them to and from their events or ministry.
