



Transportation

Providence Academy offers convenient options for bringing your children to and from our single campus in Plymouth. Providence busing service can be arranged for curbside at your residence, stop in your neighborhood, or a nearby shuttle stop. The same driver serves your family throughout the year and will often service a route for multiple years as a reliable partner in your child's safe travel to and from school.

We also offer "late bus" service to accommodate after school activities. Other transportation options available include parent drop-off and pickup, car pools, as well as Wayzata School District (#284) provided transportation (for residents), and Plymouth Dial-A-Ride services (for residents).

Providence Academy provides busing for Kindergarten through 12th grade students. Busing is also available to Pre-Kindergarten students when accompanied by an older sibling. Transportation Intent Forms are sent via an email link in May and must be completed by June 8th to ensure service and proper staffing for our routes. **2018-2019 rates are included below.**

I. Premium Service

- Providence Academy provided curbside pick up and/or drop off at your residence.
- Round-trip (AM/PM): \$2,835
- One-way (AM or PM): \$2,135
- Discounts for siblings; 25% off each additional child
- Eligible for Late Bus service at an additional cost of:
\$1,835 per student per year, or
\$715 per student per sport season

II. Neighborhood Service

- Providence Academy provided curbside pick up and/or drop off at one location in a given neighborhood for two or more families.
- Round-trip (AM/PM): \$1,930
- One-way (AM or PM): \$1,440
- Discounts for siblings; 25% off each additional child
- Eligible for Late Bus service at an additional cost of:
\$1,835 per student per year, or
\$715 per student per sport season

III. Shuttle Service

- Providence Academy provided pick up and/or drop off at one of the following locations: Pax Christi (Eden Prairie), Holiday Station-Hwy 55 (Rockford)
- New locations may be added based on density of ridership.
- Round-trip (AM/PM): \$1,720
- One-way (AM or PM): \$1,320
- Discounts for siblings; 25% off each additional child
- Eligible for Late Bus service at an additional cost of:
\$1,835 per student per year, or
\$715 per student per sport season

IV. Car Pools

- Providence Academy will provide a list of all families who are interested in carpooling to those who inquire about this option.
