# Online Registration

- In the computer lab with Mrs. Semsch the week of March 4.
- Login as STUDENT (yourself) to NetClassroom
  - Instructions under "Additional Links"
- Students will not request math (auto enrollment) or other core requirements.
- Request Language (current 7<sup>th</sup> grade) & elective (current 5<sup>th</sup>-7<sup>th</sup>)
- Request Fine Art and White Period Electives
  - FIRST choice only
- Click Submit
- Credit count = irrelevant for MS students (this matters in Upper School)

# Student/Parent Review of Courses in NetClassroom

- Login again to NetClassroom, still as the student
- Student shows parent course requests
- Parents agree = no further action needed
   Parents and students decide together to change something = change the selections
  - in NetC up until the registration deadline, March 12th.

## Accounts on Hold

- If NetClassroom is on hold, notification when you attempt to log in.
  - Business Office Hold- your parents need to contact Mrs. Determan in the business office before you can request courses.
  - E-mail Mrs. Semsch your course selections so that when the hold is fixed, your selections can be put into the computer system.

#### **Course Offerings- Electives**

- Full-Year Electives (4x per week): Concert Band, Chorus, Speech & Drama, String Ensemble, Music Appreciation & 2D-Art
- Semester Electives (2x per week): Study Hall, Athletics, Film Studies (all for 6-8), Woodshop (7-8)

Investigations in Math IIPre-Algebra

Honors Level Courses are offered at the Inv. II, Pre-Alg., Alg. I, and Geo., levels, pending meeting prerequisites and honors application approval

Our "Regular" (non-honors) courses are referred to as "College Prep," because all PA classes offered at each grade level adequately prepare students for a variety of college options after high school.

#### **6th Grade Math Placement**

- Committee of teachers, principals, and counselor look at:
  - Current (5th grade) math performance (level & grades)
  - ERB CTP 5 Scores
  - Placement test score (taken in late spring)
  - Feedback/input from teachers about students' math work habits, interest, and study skills

• Communicated to families via letter in June

#### Regular Math (College-Prep) Regular Math (College-Prep)

- For those entering 7th & 8th grade
- No need to apply for anything
- Automatic Enrollment in the next course in the sequence
- Prerequisite = 70% or better in the current math course

**Honors Math** 

#### Regular Math (College-Prep)

- For those entering 7th & 8th grade
- Need to complete intent form that will be e-mailed from Mr. Tiffany on/near Feb. 7, 2019, indicating choice not to proceed with next honors course
- Must be completed by February 13, 2019
- Prerequisite: 70% or better to proceed to the next non-honors course in the sequence
- If Honors course grade year average is below 83%, this part is done for you.

#### **Honors Math**



- For those entering 7th & 8th grade
- Need to complete intent form that will be e-mailed from Mr. Tiffany on/near Feb. 7, 2019 indicating choice to proceed with next honors course
- Must be completed by February 13, 2019
   If not eligible to proceed with bonors at this till
  - If not eligible to proceed with honors at this time, may apply in late May. Stay tuned for that information toward the end of semester II.
- Prerequisite = 83% or better in current honors course

#### **Regular (College-Prep) Math**



#### **Honors Math**

- For those entering 7th & 8th grade
- Fill out Honors Application
  - e-mailed from Mr. Tiffany on/near Feb. 7, 2019
- Application due February 13, 2019
  - If not eligible to apply for honors at this time, may apply in late May. Stay tuned for that information toward the end of semester II.
- Prerequisite = 93% or better in non-honors course, approval of department chair
- Teacher advice to apply is *not* a guarantee of approval
- Will be notified of approval or denial via e-mail by the time registration for courses opens

#### In the future...

• In Upper School, there will be honors level courses in *many* subject areasstay informed on what the offerings are, and the procedures for applying.

• You can change year-to-year whether or not you are in honors courses (math in MS and others in US), you are not "stuck in a lane" for the rest of your education.

# Language Choice for current 7<sup>th</sup> graders entering 8<sup>th</sup> grade

- French I, Latin I, Latin II, Spanish I
- Deferral/waiver
  - PA's general recommendation is to take a language in 8<sup>th</sup> grade.

# What happens next?

- Requests are used for staffing and master schedule creation (ongoing)
- Course requests remain available for viewing online this spring
  - Parent approval assumed, parents can contact Mrs. Semsch with changes if necessary.

# What happens next (cont'd)

- Course repeats are communicated to counselor/Academic Director (math & language)
- Course change requests: up to 2<sup>nd</sup> day of school next year
- \$50 fee!
  - Discouraged!
