University of Sioux Falls Basketball

Hailey has attended Providence Academy since sixth grade. While she participates in a different sport each season (fall - cross country, winter - basketball, spring - track and field), Hailey's true passion lies with basketball. Her dedication to the sport has shined throughout the years, earning her several accolades, including Most Improved Player awards (2016, 2018), All Conference recognition (2017 - Honorable Mention, 2018), and team captain status (2018, 2019). Additionally, Hailey broke her own school record in 2018 with 102 steals (previous record of 70

steals). This record also drew statewide attention when she was recognized as one of the top 10 players in steals (all classes). Beyond the court, Hailey volunteers with PACMAN, the school's community service group, and Feed My Starving Children; and leads basketball and track and field camps.

Maddie has attended Providence Academy since Kindergarten. She has participated in both cross country and track and field since eighth grade. Her athletic ability has grown exponentially over the years and has earned her numerous awards, including consistent All-Conference recognition, consistent placement at State competition, multi-year Team MVP, and captain status in both sports (cross country - 2018, 2019; track and field - 2019). In addition to her athletic awards, Maddie holds school records in three different events: 5K run (19:03.8), 1600m run (5:03.26), and 3200m run (11:11.90). Beyond her athletic talents, Maddie has

been an exceptional leader for both teams. She has been a great role model throughout the years, and while she puts the team first, she also continues to excel individually.

Kate has attended Providence Academy since Pre-Kindergarten.
