Engineering For Kids brings science, technology, engineering, and math (STEM), to kids in a fun and challenging way and inspires children to build on their natural curiosity by teaching engineering concepts through hands-on learning.

New! The Science of the Human Body & Biomedical Solutions

Take a closer look at the science of the human body when you join our Biomedical Engineering camp! Through learning-by-doing experiences, you'll begin to unravel the mysteries of the human body by running for a minute to measure heart rate, approximate energy expenditure and discover the importance of refueling with proper nutrition. You'll explore how canes, artificial legs, and other therapeutic and assistive devices are developed; and identify the necessary tools to keep an injured heart going, such as balloon catheters, stents, and valves. You'll use the Engineering Design Process to design, create, test, and refine basic solutions related to insulation, artificial heart valves, prosthetics, surgical instruments, and diagnostic tools such as a model thermometer. Maintaining health and fitness is a lifelong endeavor, and before you know it, YOU will be the architect who supports healthy, comfortable living.

New! 3D Printing: Build Your Own Robot

Students will be learning the ropes of 3D modeling and printing. They will use 3D pens to understand printing in plastic and use CAD software (computer-aided design) to design parts for their robot to be 3D printed. At the end of the week, they will have a dc-motor-powered robot to take home.

SOIL APPLICATION RESEARCH PROJECT

This summer, the Soil Application Research Program will track the effects of fertilizer, compost, and the novel soil amendment known as C20 on the growth of river birch trees and swamp white oak trees growing on Providence Academy's property. Additionally, participants will look at how these amendments affect aspects of soil chemistry and soil biology. Students participating in the program will engage in multiple phases of the scientific research process, including experimental design, data collection and statistical analysis. Research will be conducted by Dr. Yvonne Boldt, in partnership with Dr. John Lloyd of Precision Organics. Our interest in this project is to examine how fertilizers, composts, and other products, impact soil microbes, and how these products impact the quality of soils for growing flowers, trees, and vegetables in urban landscapes.

Absences

Tuition will not be prorated or refunded due to school closings, family vacations or conflicting activities.
