Monday, September 26

- * Modified Uniform: Blue Out (from head to waist) **OR** Homecoming t-shirt (past or present)
 - You can wear: blue shirts, blue hats, homecoming shirts, athletic shoes and socks
 - You cannot wear: shirts or hats that are not blue, shorts
- during Lunch, "Stretch" in Gym A for 6th graders

Tuesday, September 27

- * Modified Uniform: Sunday Best (from head to toes) OR Homecoming t-shirt (past or present)
 - You can wear: neat, clean, and modest dress clothes, suits, ties, dress shoes of choice, heels (girls), khakis, athletic shoes and socks
 - You cannot wear: informal clothes, sweats, jeans/denim, shorts, dresses or skirts shorter than PA skirt length, shirts/dresses that do not cover shoulders,
- 6th grade Retreat. 6th graders may have an out-of-uniform day, with clothing that is neat, clean, and modest following the modified standards below.
- during Lunch, "Stretch" in Gym C for 8th graders

Wednesday, September 28

- · Standard and full uniform (MS Mass day), including school shoes and socks
- before school, donut breakfast treat (location: main floor link)

Thursday, September 29

- * Modified Uniform: History Day (from head to toes) **OR** Homecoming t-shirt (past or present)
 - You can wear: neat, clean, and modest clothes from any era on the poster, informal clothes from each era, hats, homecoming t-shirts (past and present), athletic shoes and socks
 - You cannot wear: dresses or skirts shorter than PA skirt length, shirts/dresses that do not cover shoulders
- 8th grade Retreat. 8th graders may have an out-of-uniform day, with clothing that is neat, clean, and modest following the modified uniform standards below.
- during Lunch, "Stretch" in Gym B for 7th graders
- purple period TODAY ("switched" with Thursday white period)

Friday, September 30

- *Modified Uniform: Homecoming t-shirt (past or present) OR PA Spirit Wear (from head to waist)
 - You can wear: Homecoming shirts, PA spirit wear, athletic shoes and socks
 - You cannot wear: other blue/gold shirts that are not PA
- during white period ("switched" with Friday purple period), PEP FEST
- * Modified Uniform Day Standards: On these days you may modify the look of your uniform . . .
 - Clothing must be neat, clean and modest, may not contain political statements or graphics or words that go against the PA Code.
 - No sunglasses, body paint, wigs or costume masks.
 - Toes and heels must be covered.
