Financial giving is strong, with a record-breaking Gala fundraiser grossing \$643,000, and an annual fund that well exceeded its goal with pledges and gifts totaling over \$1,500,000. We are so grateful for these commitments, which enhance the present and assure the future success of PA's mission to children and families.

I hear from every quarter that the mission, consistent now for twenty-one years, is being especially appreciated and is in growing demand. Our mission is captured in the three words of our motto, "Faith, Knowledge, Virtue." Faith is itself a virtue and a sure way of knowing and loving the Creator and Redeemer God and His design for us. 

PROVIDENCE ACADEMY CELEBRATES 20 YEARS!






CLASS OF 2022 HONORS

FAITH, KNOWLEDGE, VIRTUE AWARD

The highest award bestowed upon a graduating senior at Providence Academy is the Faith, Knowledge, Virtue Award. Recipients demonstrate strong Christian belief and commitment, achieve academic success through mastery of Providence's diverse and challenging curriculum, and serve as living examples of the virtues of faith, hope, charity, justice, courage and honesty. Recipients are chosen by the faculty and are awarded a \$1,500 scholarship to their chosen college or university. They are also given the honor of addressing their classmates with a valedictory speech at graduation.

SENIOR FINE ARTS AWARD

The Senior Fine Arts Award is awarded to one male and one female with outstanding accomplishments in the visual or performing arts. Recipients are nominated and selected by the Fine Arts Department faculty.

SENIOR ATHLETICS AWARD

The Senior Athletics Award is awarded to one male and one female demonstrating leadership, strong work ethic, dedication and achievement in athletics. Recipients are nominated and selected by Providence Academy's head coaches.

SENIOR HEART OF THE LION AWARD

The Heart of the Lion Award recognizes one female and one male who have demonstrated outstanding steadfastness while making exemplary contributions to the life of the school community. Each of these students have overcome obstacles in their paths, while maintaining a positive attitude, growing in virtue, and applying God's gifts for the good of others.

ACADEMIC HONORS

Each year, Providence Academy recognizes academic distinctions based on grade point average and the intensity and rigor of course selection. In the Class of 2022, six students earned Summa Cum Laude honors; nine students earned Magna Cum Laude; and eight students earned Cum Laude honors.

Additionally, the College Board recognizes students based on their Advanced Placement (AP) exams performance. Eleven students qualified for AP Scholar by passing 3 or more AP Exams. Three students earned AP Scholar with Honor by passing 4 or more exams with an average score of 3.25. Seven students earned AP Scholar with Distinction, passing 5 or more exams with an average score of 3.5.

National Honor Society members have met Providence Academy's standards of scholarship, service, leadership and character.

National Merit finalists have scored in the top 16,000 students nationally on the PSAT in the fall of their junior year.

Ryan conducts book drives and manages volunteers as well as organizing and managing the distribution of books to recipient organizations. Ryan was a member of the PA National Honor Society and graduated Cum Laude. Next year, Ryan will serve as a Missionary with NET Ministries before continuing his education, hoping to major in Catholic Studies.

Maria Counts has been a four-year varsity member of the girls basketball team. She has also served as a captain of the volleyball team and was a state tournament participant for the track and field team. On the basketball court, Maria has left a legacy at Providence Academy that will go down in the history books. She finished as the only player in school history to amass 1,000 points and 1,000 rebounds. She is 1st all-time in school history for rebounds, blocks, and assists and is 2nd all-time in steals. In her four-year career, she has a 6-and-1 record at the state basketball tournament, only losing once in the state championship game in 2021. This past year she led The Lady Lions to their 2nd-ever State Championship in basketball. Aside from her accolades, Maria has served as a captain for two years and has been instrumental in the transformation of the program. Maria plans to play basketball as a walk on at the University of Minnesota, majoring in Environmental Science.

Mark McCarthy enjoyed an outstanding football career over his four seasons as a Providence Academy Lion. Mark was part of two undefeated regular season and District Champion teams in 2018 and 2021. He was a three-year starter and varsity letter winner (2019-2021), voted All-District in 2021, and All-District Honorable Mention in 2020. Mark was elected Team Captain by his peers for the 2021 season. He played defensive end as a senior and registered 13 tackles for loss and 6.5 sacks. On offense he was a two-year starter at Tight End and led the team with three receiving touchdowns as a junior in 2020. For the good of the team, he moved to Left Tackle as a Senior and anchored an offensive line that rushed for over 2,400 yards during the season. Mark committed himself to be a leader in the weightroom and was a constant presence for all four years, working on building his strength and agility. Mark McCarthy was the epitome of what a Providence Academy football player is all about. He will continue his football career as a student athlete at UW-La Crosse.


