









Registration Deadline

In general, registration remains open at providenceacademy.org/summer until one week before the beginning of each camp. Camps may fill before that time.

Summer Program Dates

Summer Programs are offered weekdays June 13 through August 12. PALS Full-Day Camp offers a special two-day field trip session August 15-16. In observance of the Juneteenth & Independence Day holidays, no programs will be conducted on Monday, June 20 and Monday, July 4.

POLICIES & PROCEDURES

Absences

Tuition will not be prorated or refunded due to school closings, family vacations or conflicting activities. Drop-Off and Pick-Up Procedures

All students are expected to be present at the appropriate meeting location at the start of the activity and must be picked up by the end of the activity. Withdrawal & Refund Policy


