Who May Attend Prom

- All students in 11th and 12th grade are encouraged to attend
- These students may invite a student from the 10th grade
- No 9th grade students may attend Prom

Guest Policy

An 11th or 12th grade student may invite a guest from outside the PA community.

All guests must . . .

- Be a currently enrolled 10th 12th grade student
- Provide a fully completed Guest permission form
- Be approved by the Dean of Students
- Agree to abide by the PA Prom behavior and dress requirements

Event Guests

Students may purchase a ticket for a guest to this event provided that they are of the opposite sex

Prior to Prom...

BEFORE Prom all attendees must . . .

- Purchase a ticket in the US office
- Ticket fees will be charged to student accounts
- Provide a completed hard-copy of the "Prom Covenant" form (or Guest Covenant) signed by both the student and their parent/guardian
- All forms must be submitted to the US office prior to 3:15 pm on Wednesday, May 10th, 2023

Admission Requirements


When arriving at Prom, all attendees shall

- Arrive at the Prom before 7:30 pm
- Submit to an on-site breathalyzer
- Have their attire inspected
- Sign out with a chaperone if departing prior to 10 pm

Formal Dress Regulations For Ladies & Gentlemen

Guiding Principle

All attire must be in keeping with
Providence Academy's general standards of neatness, cleanliness, and modesty



The purchase of a ticket and completion of the **Prom Covenant is** an implicit consent to the follow PA's Behavior and **Formal Dress** requirements



Event Chaperones reserve the right to deny entry to any attendee whose attire does not meet PA requirements



Students will not have the opportunity to change/modify their outfits at check-in. All should arrive appropriately attired



With the exception of changing from heels to flats, students may not change/modify their outfits at any point once they have been admitted to the event



Ladies Formal Dress Requirements

Dress/Gown

- The front of the dress may rest no lower than 4 inches below the top of the sternum
- The back of the dress may rest no lower than the band of a standard bra
- There may be no visible cleavage

Ladies' Short Dress Guidelines

Short Dresses

- Dress should not exceed 4 inches above the knee
- Should be solid/opaque
- Any lace/sheer overlay is not considered when accounting for the length of the dress
- The wearing of nylons, leggings, tights, etc. does not negate the length requirement
- There may be no visible cleavage



Ladies' Formal Dress Guidelines

Dress/Gown

- May have a slit in either the front or back that is no higher than 4 inches above the knee
- May not have cut-outs or exposed midriff
- Any lace/sheer overlay is not considered when accounting for panels





Shawls, Shrugs, & Pashminas

If an outfit relies on a shawl, shrug, sweater or pashmina to meet our formal attire standards, that article of clothing must be worn for the duration of the event.



Gentlemen's' Formal Dress Requirements

Gentlemen must wear either a suit or tuxedo





If the suit has a print upon it, the subject matter of the print must be PA appropriate




The outfit must include:

- Bow tie
- Bolo tie







The outfit must include:

Belt

or

Suspenders





The outfit must include:

Shoes

&

Socks





Rule of Thumb

Match shoes to belt





If you have suspenders, don't wear a belt and vice versa.
