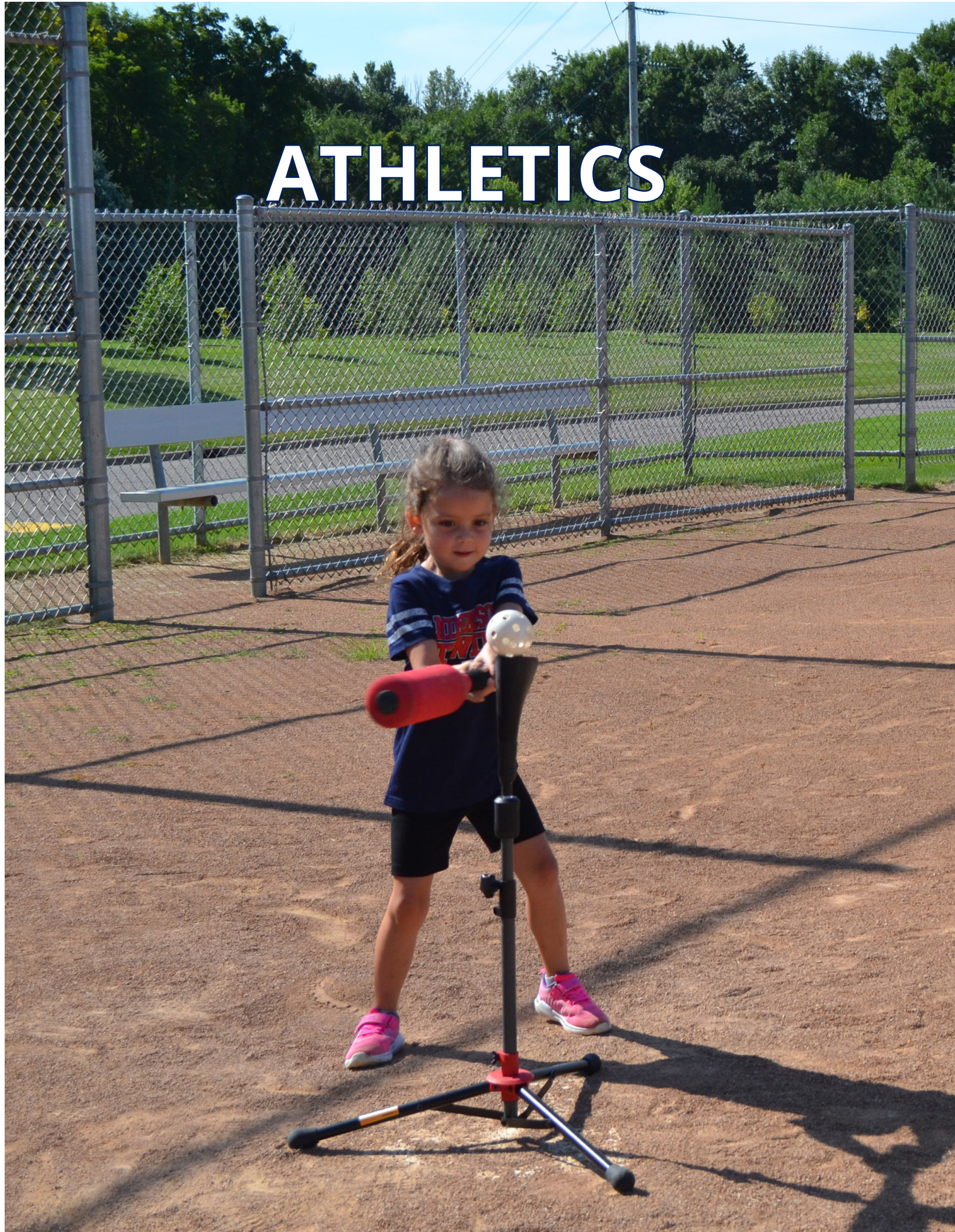

Information will also be posted inside the entrance of the building. Students should enter through the Main Entrance, Door #1.

Registration Deadline

In general, registration remains open at providenceacademy.org/summer until one week before the beginning of each camp. Camps may fill before that time.

Summer Program Dates

Summer Programs are offered weekdays June 10 through August 9. In observance of the Juneteenth & Independence Day holidays, no programs will be conducted on Wednesday, June 19 and Thursday, July 4 & Friday, July 5.

POLICIES & PROCEDURES

Absences

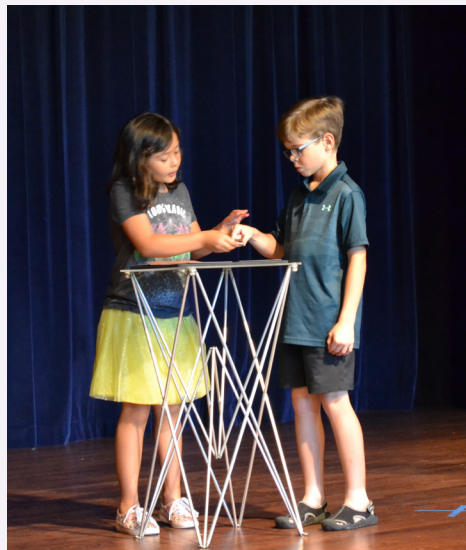
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
