2025-2026 District Funding Forms

Student Parking 2025-2026

Any student who drives to school and parks on Providence Academy property must register their vehicle **and** display a 2025-2026 parking permit in the window of the vehicle. Once registered, a student driver will be issued one permit for both the primary and secondary vehicle listed.

- There will be **50% discount** for registrations received through this form prior to August 25, 2025. The **\$75.00** fee will be charged to student's accounts.
- Registrations received through this form between August 25 and September 12, 2025 will receive the standard fee of **\$150.00** charged to the student's account.
- After September 12, 2025, vehicles without permits will be identified and a **\$200.00** charge will be placed on the student's account.

Driving to and from Providence Academy and parking in its lot is a privilege and not a right. Student drivers must understand that failure to drive safely, respect Providence Academy rules and property or the property of others, may result in have their parking permit suspended or revoked.

*Note - if your student will not be driving until second semester, he or she should stop by the US office to pick up a Parking Registration Form at that time
