RETREAT ESSENTIALS

- Outdoor Shoes or Rain Boots (footwear that can get wet/muddy)
- Second pair of closed-toe "dry" shoes
- Reusable Water Bottle
- Pillow
- Sleeping bag and/or sheets & blanket
- Towel & Washcloth
- Soap, Shampoo, Conditioner
- Toothbrush & Toothpaste
- Sunscreen Non-aerosol (seasonal)
- Backpack or Drawstring bag
- Medications
- Rosary
- Bible

CLOTHING

- Socks - several pairs
- Undergarments
- Sweater/Fleece/Sweatshirt
- Long Pants (even when warm)
- Shorts (as weather dictates)
- Shirts (short & long per weather)

- Pajamas
- Hat (as weather dictates)
- Rain Gear (jacket and other rainwear as desired)

OPTIONAL

- Insect repellent - non-aerosol
- Spending money for the Trinity Woods store
- Camera (not on a tablet, cell phone, or other device)
- Sunglasses
- Watch
- Swimsuit for waterfront and river trips (necessity is dependent on weather)

DO NOT BRING:

Electronics - hair dryers/straighteners, video games, MP3 players, student cell phones, chewing gum, or illegal substances - tobacco, alcohol, drugs, firearms or other weapons.

Please note, there will be a postage fee for any items left at camp that need to be mailed back to the school or an individual.
